**Better Care Fund: Workshops**

**Case study 1 – Sally \***

58 year old woman with pain in her neck and back. Recently suffered a broken ankle.

**Case study 2 - Shola**

62 year old woman suffering from swallowing problems following elective surgery to remove slipped disc. Lives with her husband but no children.

**Case study 3 - Anjali**

80 year old woman living on her own, speaks little English, has no support from her family. She is finding it difficult to carry out daily tasks, unsteady on her feet and her mood is low.

**Case study 4 - Dennis**

87-year old man lives with his daughter. He had a fall which resulted in hospital admission. He gets breathless when he walks short distances.

The daughter works full time and is often busy at weekends and evenings, and may have mental health issues.

**Case study 5 – Mary \***

62 year old woman, retired nurse has problems with her voice and swallowing.

She was subsequently diagnosed with motor neurone disease.

**Case study 6 - Linda**

72 year old woman fell and broke her kneecap. She lives on her own and may need further surgery.

**Case study 7 - Charlie**

23 year old man fell down the stairs many years ago. He still requires rehabilitation many years later.

**Case study 8 - Rajesh**

43 year old man in hospital due to stroke. He was discharged to a nursing home.

He has many conditions including cerebral palsy and schizophrenia.
